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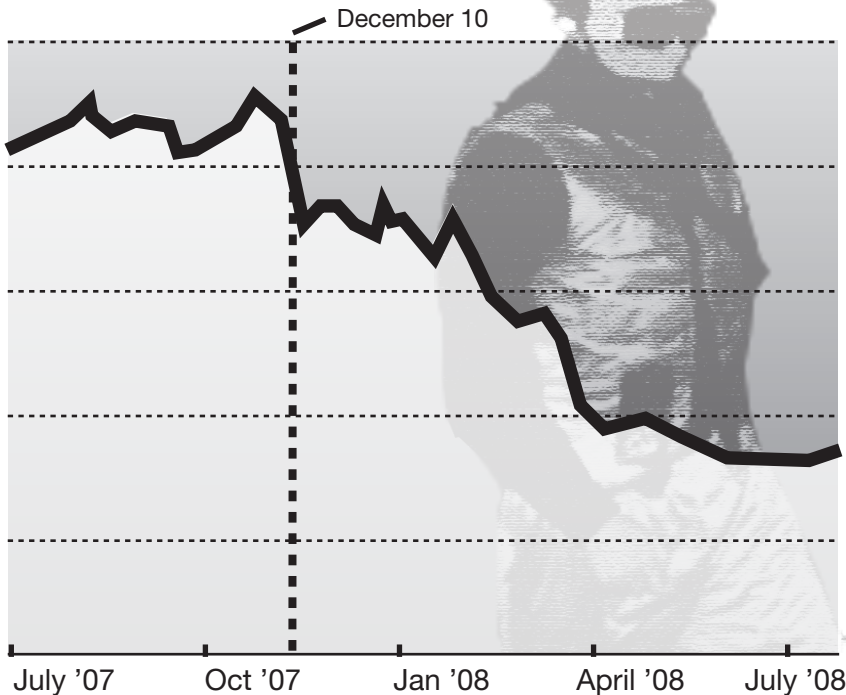

ROBOTS DEFEAT CLINTON MACHINE

Campaign poll numbers plummet
after Robot Army incursion

MR-IFOBCA Victorious

IOWA CITY - Following Hillary Clinton's withdrawal from the presidential race, a representative for the widely feared robot army, MR-IFOBCA, claimed responsibility for the campaign's collapse.

On December 10, 2007, roughly four weeks before Clinton's surprising defeat in the Iowa caucuses, the president of the Iowa City chapter of MR-IFOBCA (Mad Robots In Favor of Bill Clinton Apologizing, which is not affiliated with Mr. Roboto) confronted Bill Clinton about past misdeeds while he was stumping for his wife.
